Get recognition for your ecological and environmental focus by entering the 2019 Golf Environment Awards.

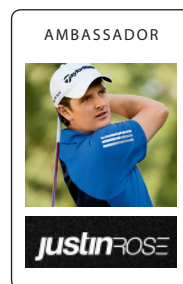
